We all commit sin. Sins are the things that we think, say, and do that make God angry. We all have the same problem. We are not only sinners by nature, but also sinners **by choice**. This puts us all in a hopeless position, making us all guilty before God, because "whoever shall keep the whole law [God's law], and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all." (The Bible, James 2:10) However, Jesus Christ, God's perfect Son, came to rescue us from our hopeless state about 2000 years ago. He left the glories of

heaven, was born as a human being, and lived a sinless life. Then, because of His infinite love for us, He allowed Himself to be tortured, and nailed to a cross to die for the sins of all mankind.
